

Navigation Lights

As one of our Members sadly discovered on the Middle Harbour trip, Maritime Authorities are enforcing the regulations relating to lighting required while a vessel is underway after sunset. As detailed below, it is a regulation to be showing an “all round navigation light” in addition to the port and starboard coloured lights. The drawing below gives an indication, or the details are available on the RMS site. So either only be underway in the daylight (like we do) or use your anchor light or another auxiliary light – it will save the hip pocket!
